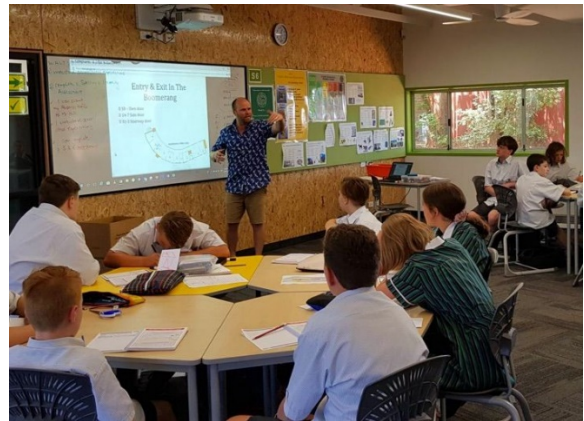
Freya

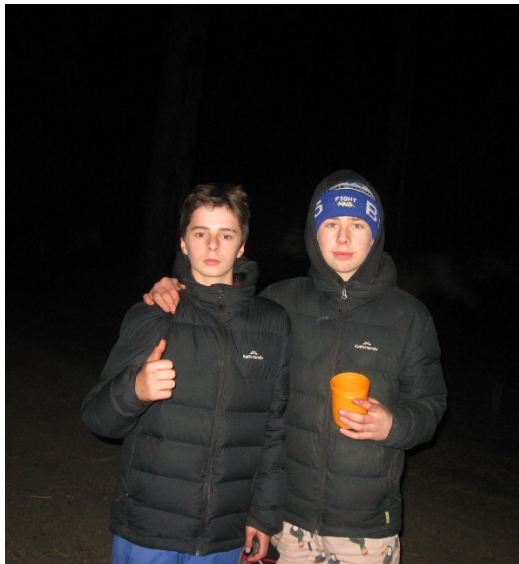
About Kyneton
